

Enclosed is the announcement of the Relocation Trust fee from MN Housing. On September 1st, all park residents in State of MN will be charged the annual fee of **\$15.00**. To be eligible to participate in the fund, you must pay the annual fee by October 31, 2022. This can be paid with rent in one check. ## Cucumber Tomato Salad

- \* 3 Cups peeled and sliced cucumbers
- \* 3 Roma tomatoes, sliced into chunks
- \* 1/3 cup chopped red onion
- \* 1/4 cup olive oil
- \* 3/4 cup apple cider vinegar
- \* 1/2 Tbsp red wine vinegar
- \* 1/2 tsp dill weed
- \* 1 tsp sugar
- \* 1/4 tsp each of salt & pepper
